

# Rules and Regulations

## *For Post-Secondary Enrollment Option (PSEO) Students*

- Students must have an ACT composite score of 19 or above or COMPASS test scores on file in the Admissions Office.
- Students who receive a grade below a “C” in any post-secondary course will not be eligible to enroll for additional courses under the post-secondary provision at Southwestern Community College.
- Students who receive an incomplete grade will not be allowed to register for additional post-secondary courses until the incomplete has been changed to a “C” grade or above.
- Students who fail or withdraw from any post-secondary class, after the first week, are responsible for payment of all tuition, fees and book expenses.
- Course(s) dropped after the full-refund period, will be subject to Southwestern’s Refund Policy.
- Students who withdraw from classes two consecutive semesters will be unable to register for further post-secondary classes.
- Students are responsible for following the instructor’s attendance policy.
- Both mid-term and final grades will be mailed to the student’s local school district.
- Book policy – Student is responsible for checking with high school counselor or principal.
